

2	Summary Ribbon	A ribbon with clickable tiles that display a birds-eye view of workload.

3	Flowtime Page Tabs	 Processes List: the page that displays the processes that the end user has permission for. Delegations: the page where end users delegate control of processes to other users with requisite permission. HotOperations: the page where end users perform real-time work optimization and case management.
4	Inbox Items	A table that includes open and closed messages that end users received for process tasks.
5	Processes I Started	A table where end users can view and connect to their open and closed processes. Click the three dot button next to a process to view available actions.
