# **Add Connection Credentials**


#### Overview

All connections to external services need to be authenticated. You can create different credential types based on the service authentication requirements.

- Username Password: Basic authentication using username and password.
- OAuth2 Client Credentials: Connects with external services using client confidential authentication.
- OAuth2 On Behalf Credentials: Connects with external services using a delegated user identity authentication.

### Procedure

- 1. In the Administration site, go to **Administration>Global Settings>Credentials**.
- 2. Click Add Credentials.




- 3. Select the credential type:
  - o Username Password
  - o OAuth2 Client Credentials
  - o OAuth2 On Behalf Credentials



### Create a Username Password credential

- 1. On the Add Record To: Credentials page, add the following details:
  - Name: A unique credential name.
  - User Name: Credential username.
  - o Password: Credential password.
  - o Confirm Password: Reenter the same password to confirm.



2. Click **Add**.
